7. Two (2) reference letters, one of which must be from your Principal or a teacher at your school. The second letter may be from a notable person in your life, some examples include but are not restricted to, a church leader, sports coach, leader of a youth group, etc.
8. An essay of no more than **400 words**, which should state how the ISEP scholarship will benefit *you, your family, your community and your country*. Explain how it will assist you in achieving your future goals and ambitions. List three (3) personal goals you wish to achieve while on the scholarship, if selected, and also indicate any special qualities or attributes which you possess, that you consider are noteworthy to support your application.

All required supporting documents must be provided in print/hard copy.
